

**NAME**

CURLOPT\_LOCALPORT – set local port number to use for socket

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_LOCALPORT, long port);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

Pass a long. This sets the local port number of the socket used for the connection. This can be used in combination with *CURLOPT\_INTERFACE(3)* and you are recommended to use *CURLOPT\_LOCALPORTRANGE(3)* as well when this option is set. Valid port numbers are 1 - 65535.

**DEFAULT**

0, disabled - use whatever the system thinks is fine
